Vehicle B-Prefixes/Running Numberset, First Part, Combinations

Sheets FRH7801-7807

These sets make light work of wagon numbering when combined with the Second Part combinations in **Sheets FRH7901-7907**. NB: 000 combinations are provided in **FRH 801**.

Full provision has been made for easily applying prefix-plus-4/5/6-digit numbersets without the need for intricate cutting. For black background patches, see **Sheet FRH7905**

The second of our vehicle specific marking kits. Enough for 3 or 4 vans dependent on sheet.

2 sheets

FRH7815/1 gives all white panel material on clear grounds, usually for bauxite liveries.

FRH7815/2 gives the optional black grounds usually for the grey liveries. The use of black backgrounds on traffic/data panels is optional, usually according to livery.

For wagons with discharge doors in the floor.

End Discharge Slash

Sheet FRH7909

For wagons with end discharge doors.

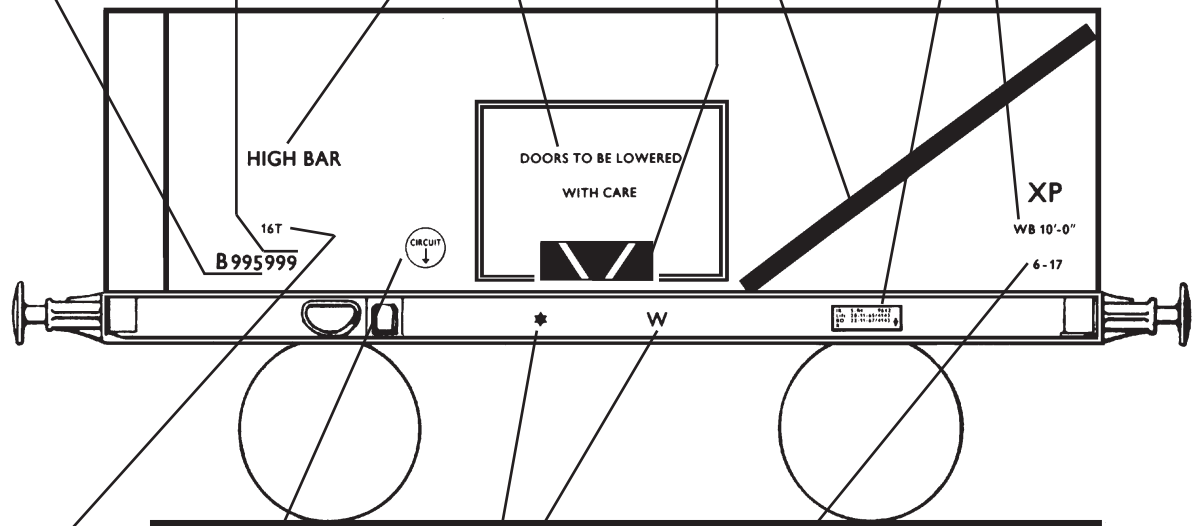
